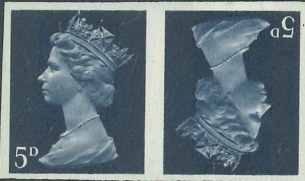

1972 £1 Black Machin, Imperf pair.



1968 5d Dark Blue, Imperf pairs, the left hand pair are tête bêche, probably from a booklet pane.



1970 Christmas 4d Machin (last £sd Christmas), Dramatic mis-perf at a peculiar angle.



1980 50p Ochre with middle between tow stamps Imperf and left hand side badly torn.



1985 34p Alfred Hitchcock showing on left side Queens head and 34p dropped down and right side normal stamp. Probably caused by faulty register on second print run.





1971 Machin heads, from booklet, 1/2p, 6p, 2p, 1p, showing Doctor blade flaw in two horizontal green stripes where the ink has not been cleared.

1969 Christmas 1/6 multicoloured showing missing gold on left hand stamp, so no Queen' head and detail above arches. Normal stamp on right.



1996 £2 Blue Machin head, showing left hand stamp has missing £ sign.



1982 19 1/2p Girls Brigade, left hand stamp showing perf alignment shifted to left so the right hand side figures & the Queen's head are now on the right. Normal stamp to right





1971 9p Light Blue Machin, showing mis-perfs through to the margin.



1979 Christmas 8p, multicoloured, showing traffic lights in middle with Ochre dropped downwards and thus this results in Ochre dropping down on the stamps.



1979 Miniature sheet 11 1/2p issued in honour of Rowland Hill. The left hand side shows boy with Yellow instead of a red coat. The right hand side stamp is normal. The margin colour to the left hand side side stamp appears to be faded/lighter compared to right, is this light fading or genuine error?

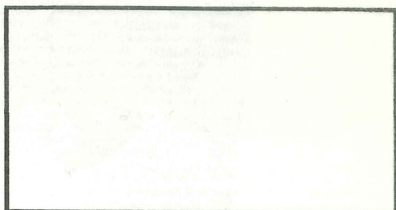

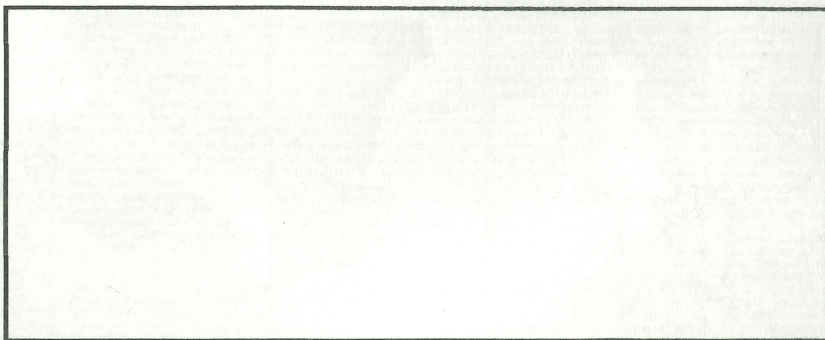


QEII 1958 3d showing misperforation at a very odd angle.

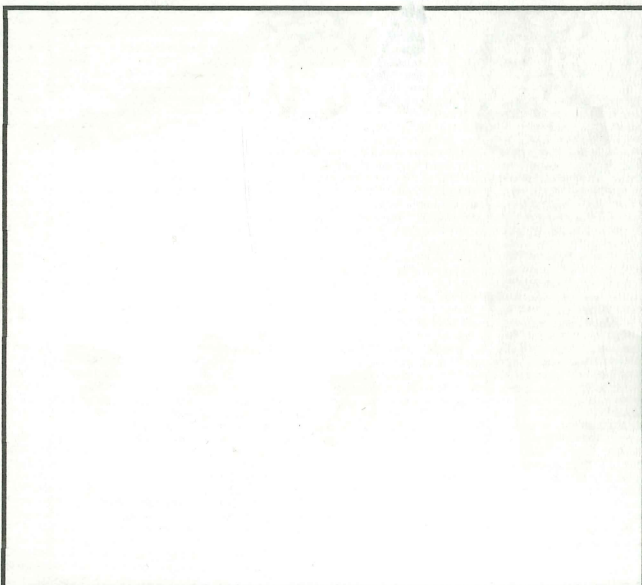


QEII 1992 £1.50 showing the letters Caernarfon Castle at the top of the stamp instead of the bottom.
