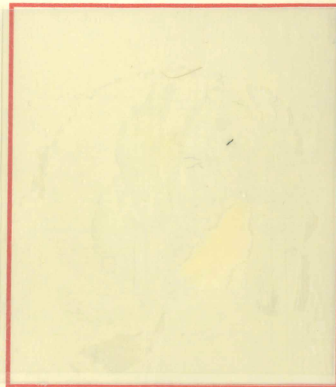

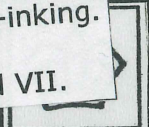

Note that this period covered Edward VII.



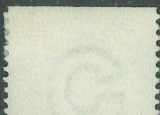
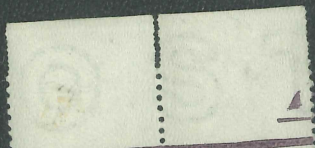
