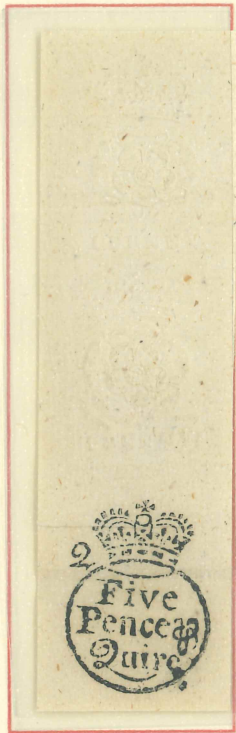


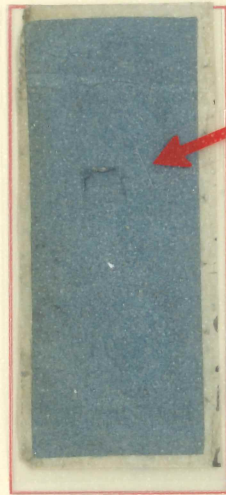
REVENUE EMBOSSED WILLIAM III, ANNE, GEORGE I - III.

These are samples of embossed stamps which are early Revenue Stamps made by the Stamp Office. Cypher Stamp on the back.

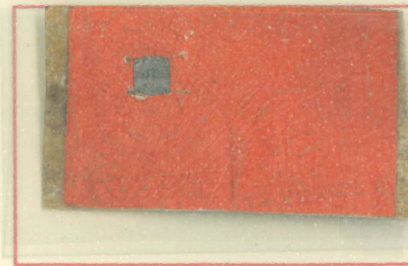
First issued 28 June 1694, to pay for William III 's wars. Later a tin staple is used to hold the stamp to the document to show tax has been paid.

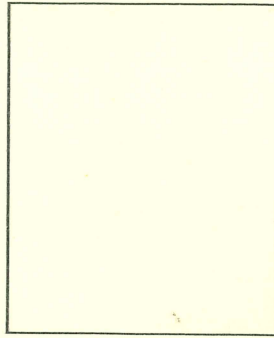
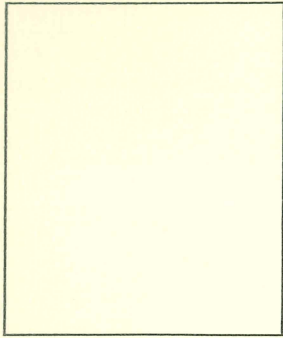

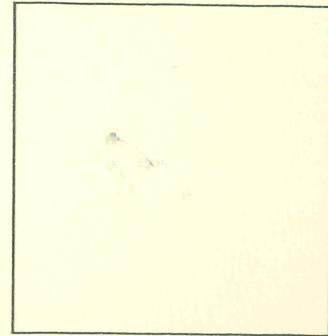
MISCELLANEOUS EMBOSSED STAMPS SPECIMEN 7, 9 & 11
