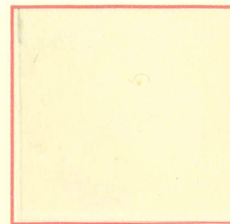

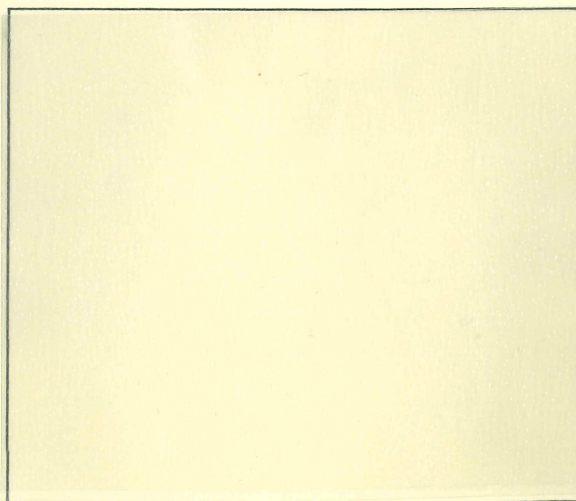

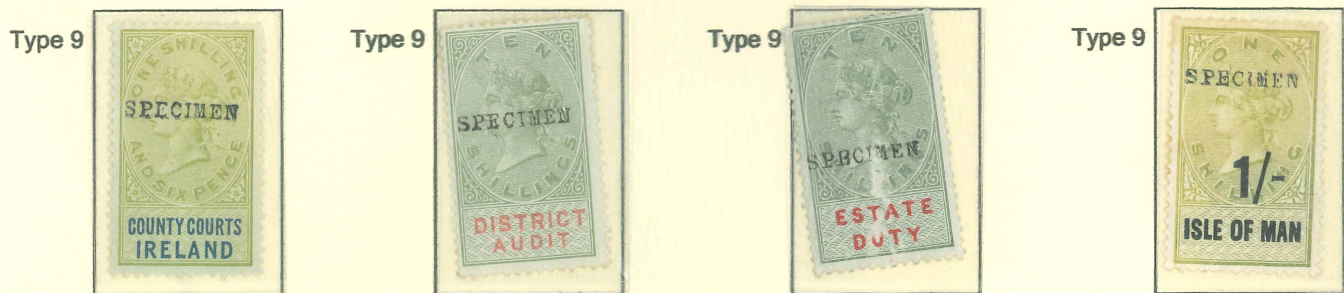
# 2nd & 8th SIZE REVENUE STAMPS C-J SPECIMEN TYPES 9 & 10

Some unusual stamps with the Ireland Petty Sessions with the 6d in two different colours.

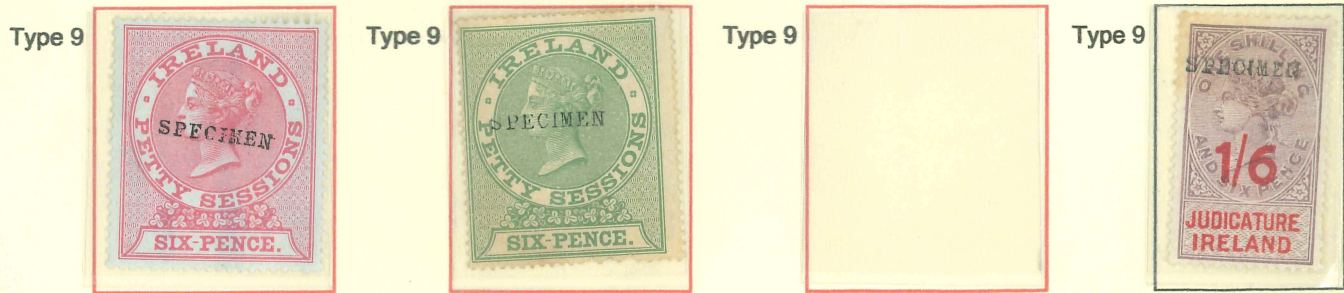
Revenue stamps come in different sizes and these are 4mm taller than 1st Size, and the Irish 8th Size are 9mm wider.

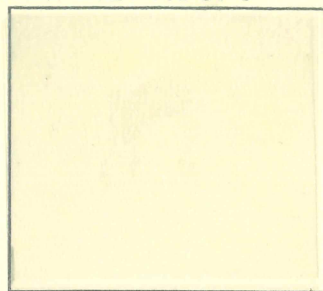

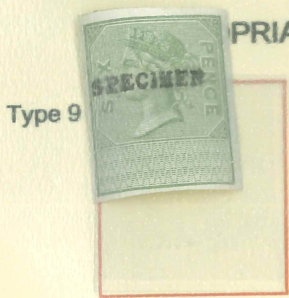

# 1st & 2A SIZE REVENUE STAMPS B-L SPECIMEN TYPES 9 AND 15

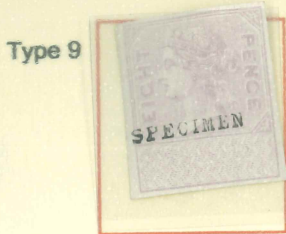
There are multiple purposes for these Unappropriated Die stamps, but primarily they are for taxation.

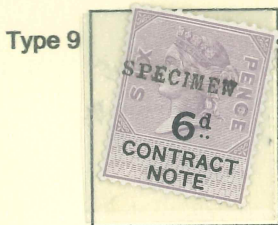

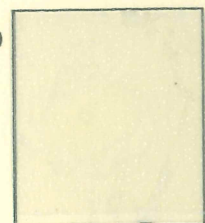
