

ENVELOPES JANUARY 1841 POSTAL NOTICE SPECIMEN PS1 & PS2

The significant item is that the January 1841 Postal Notice contained envelopes, made from surplus Mulready paper. These are the very first examples of SPECIMEN OP in British Postal History. Huggins SPECIMENS PS1 and PS2.

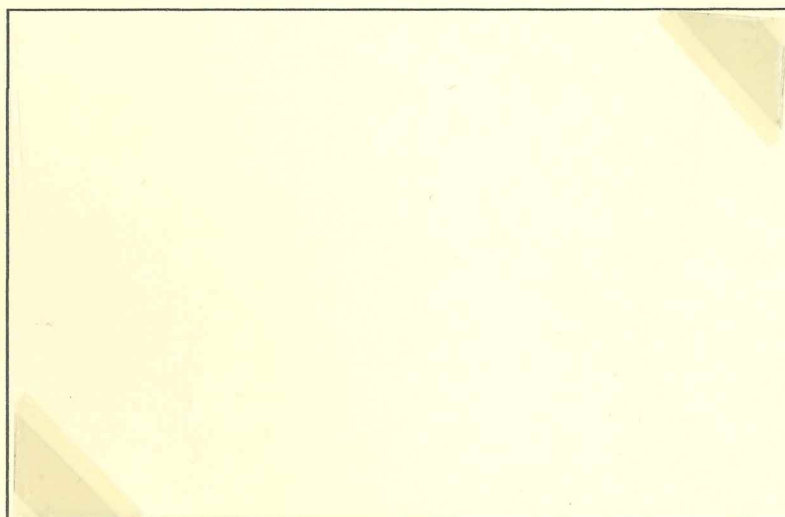
