

NB: Proofs? Quarter Annas are clichés 1 & 2, both apparently from the top of the sheet - this occurs only in Setting III; One Anna is apparently from position 3 - cliché 1 occurs here only in Setting III and VI, but shade agrees better with Setting III. State of flaws is inconclusive; tablets are clear of ink clotting; shades are somewhat similar to those of Setting III. CDS's are of Kuala Lumpur (!) All from P. Röver.

Ultra Letter File



TRAVANCORE-COCHIN

Formed in 1949, as a roll up of the erstwhile Travancore and Cochin states; survived until 1951. It used for the most part Travancore stamps (a few with Cochin watermarks) surcharged in INDIAN currency

The combined State was allowed unusual latitude, in the matter of postage rates (lower) and in the use of its stamps to addresses in India and overseas. (Covers exist, but they are uncommon and philatelic.)

Otherwise, a paradise for collectors of philatelic oddities: imperf between etc.:
