The Dail President or his secretary (card signed [EAMON] DE Valera) did not know the postal rates. On November 8, 1922, the foreign printed matter rate was 1/2 penny for the first 2 ounces. The domestic letter rate was 2 pence. Card was overpaid by 1 1/2 pence.

NOTE: The signature on the reverse is not that of President DE Valera. He signed in Gaelic, there is no letter 'V' in Gaelic. Most likely it was signed by his secretary.

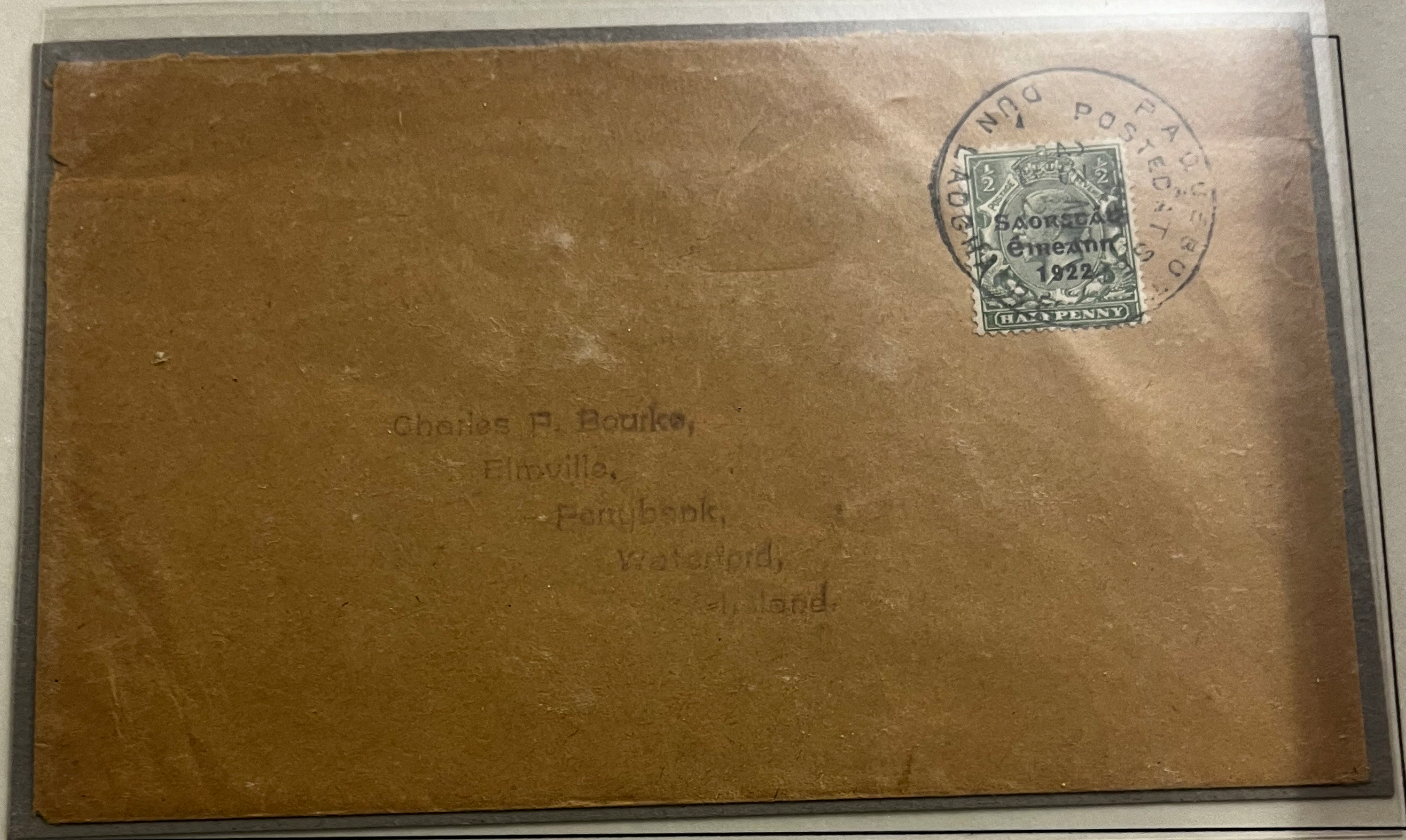

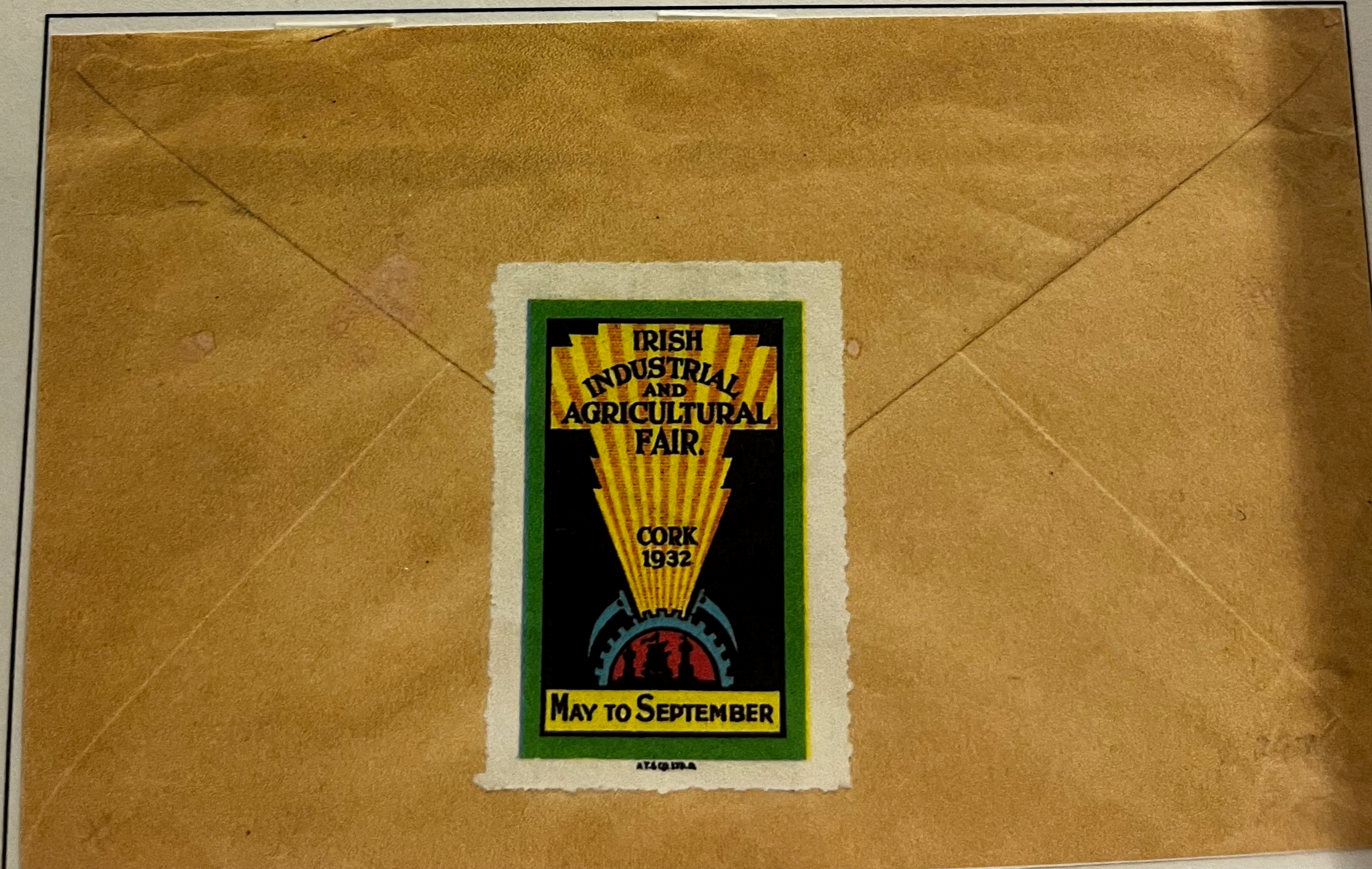

Paqetbot (packet boat cancel) Posted at Sea, Dun Laoghaire, County Dublin. April 4, 1932.



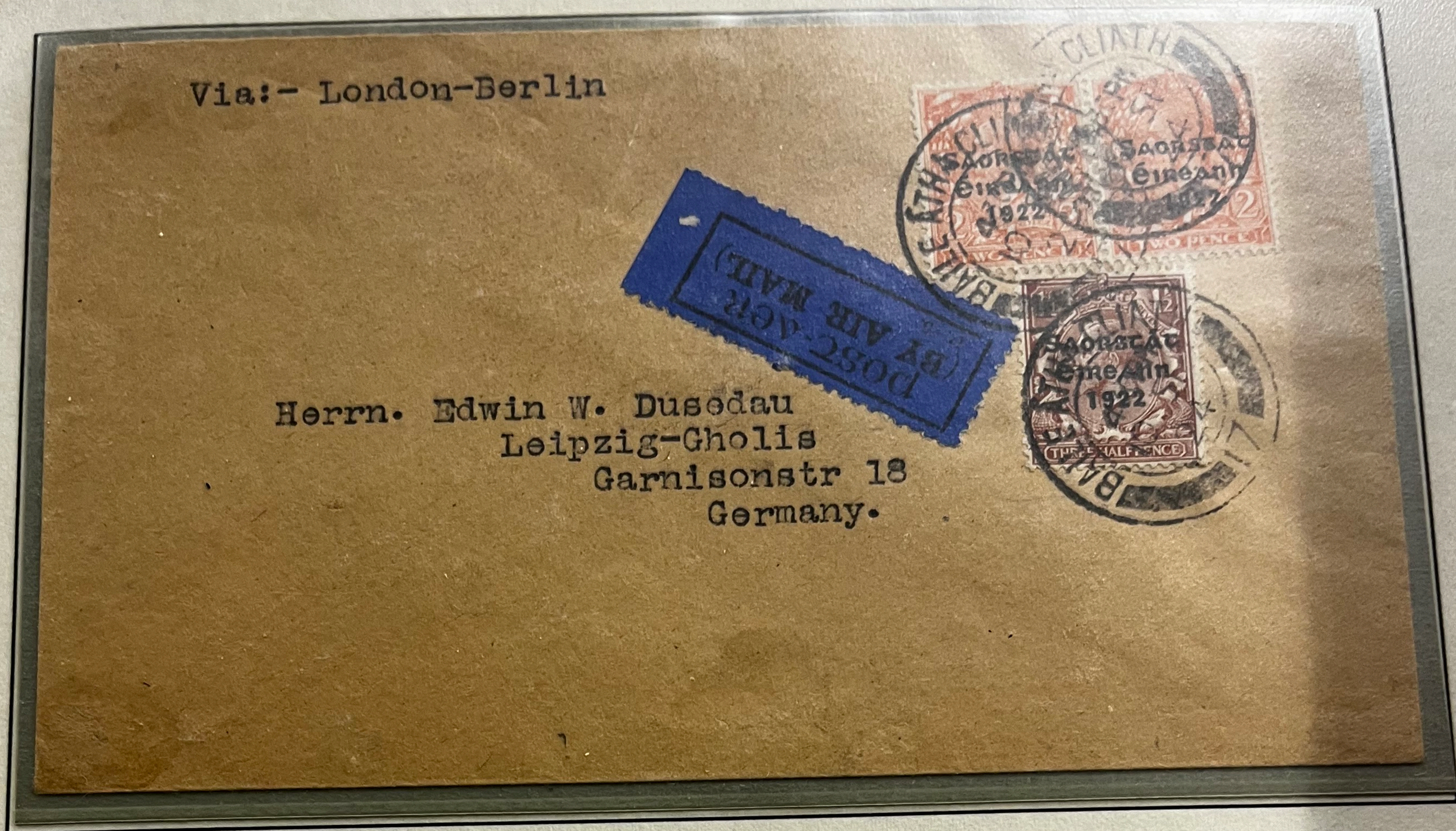

The London -Berlin air surcharge was 3 pence per ounce. The British foreign rate 2 1/2 pence per ounce. Total of 5 1/2 pence. The Irish foreign letter rate 3 pence per ounce (to 1 ounce), so the franking should have been 6 pence.

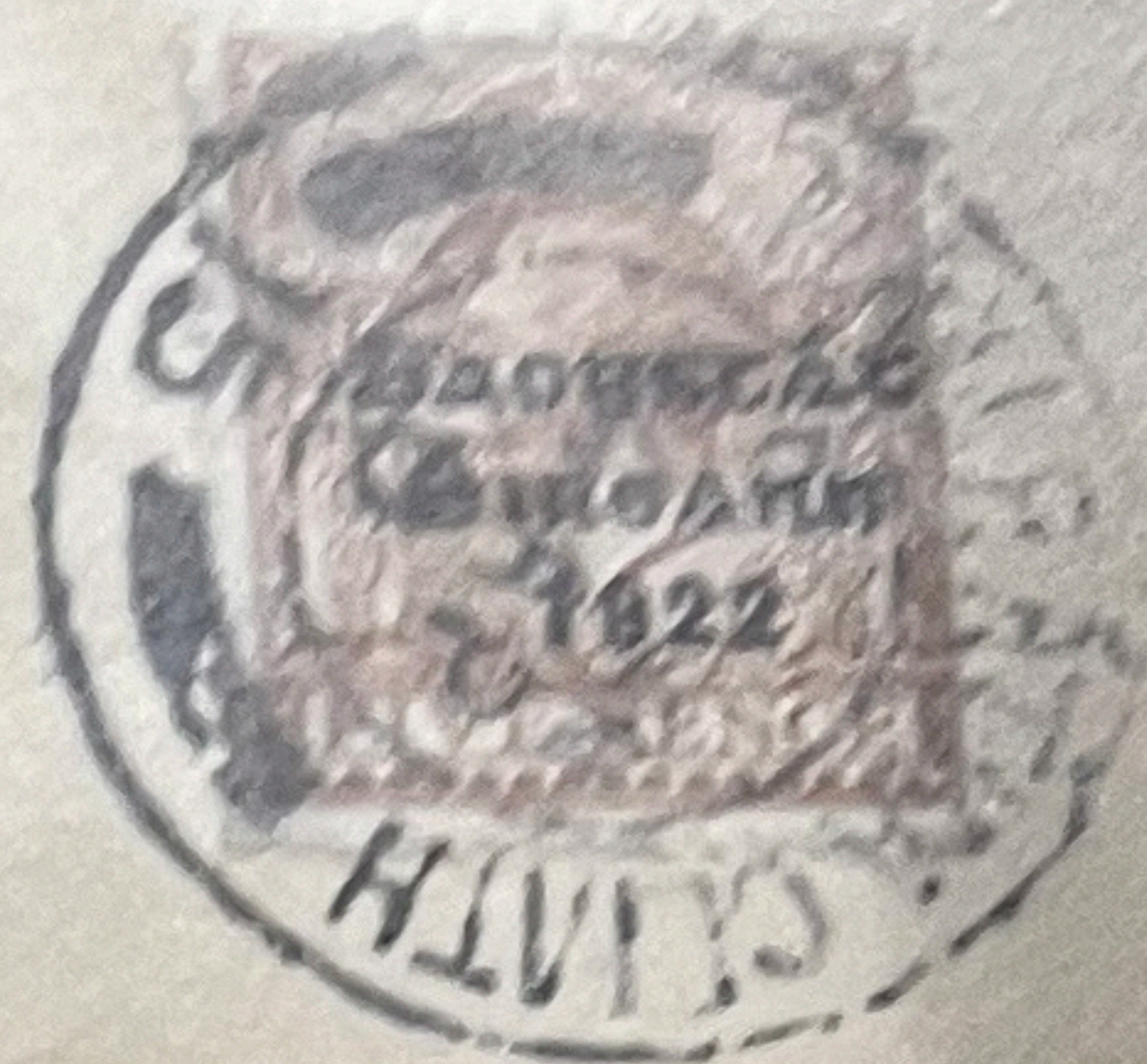

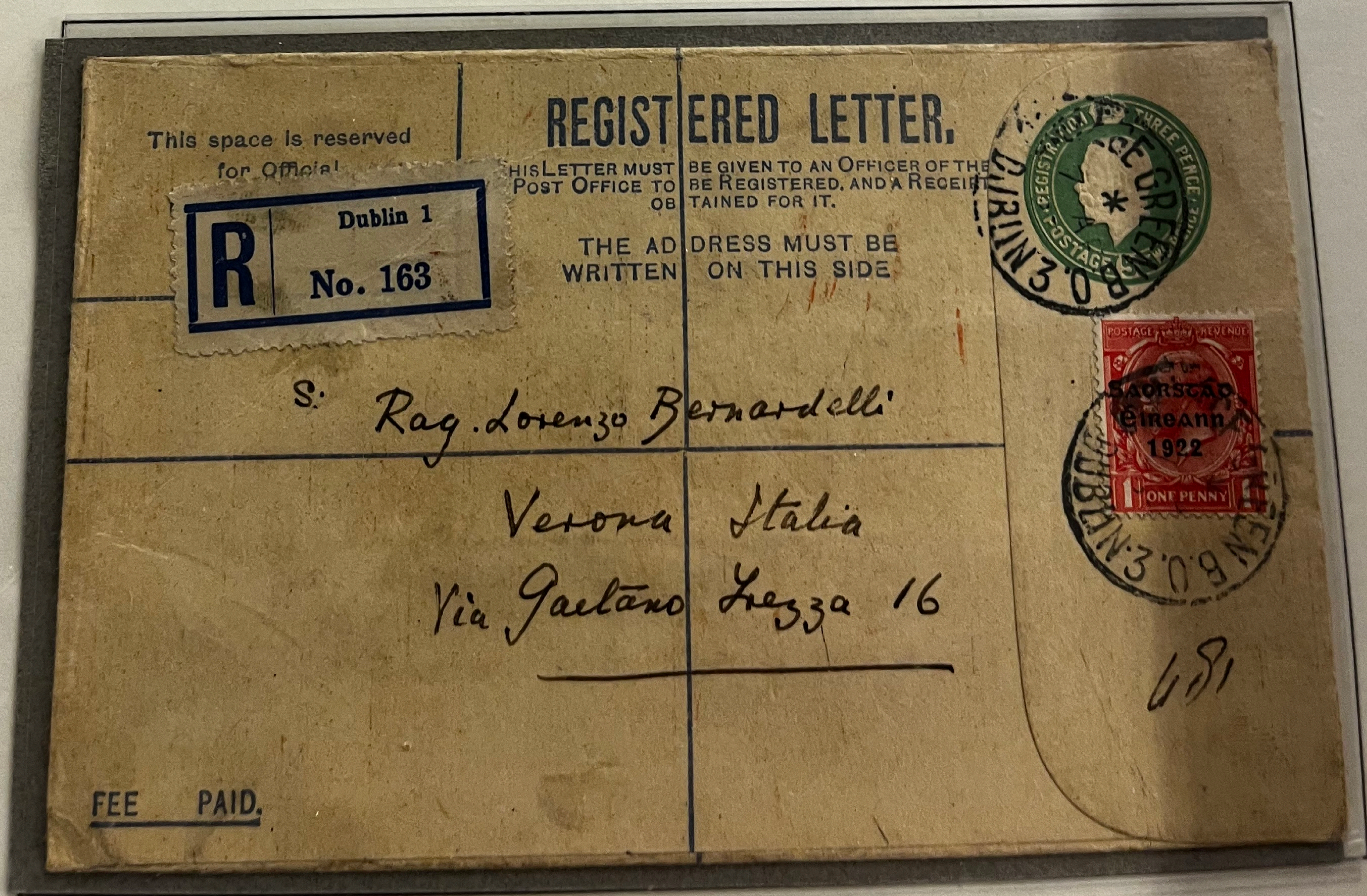

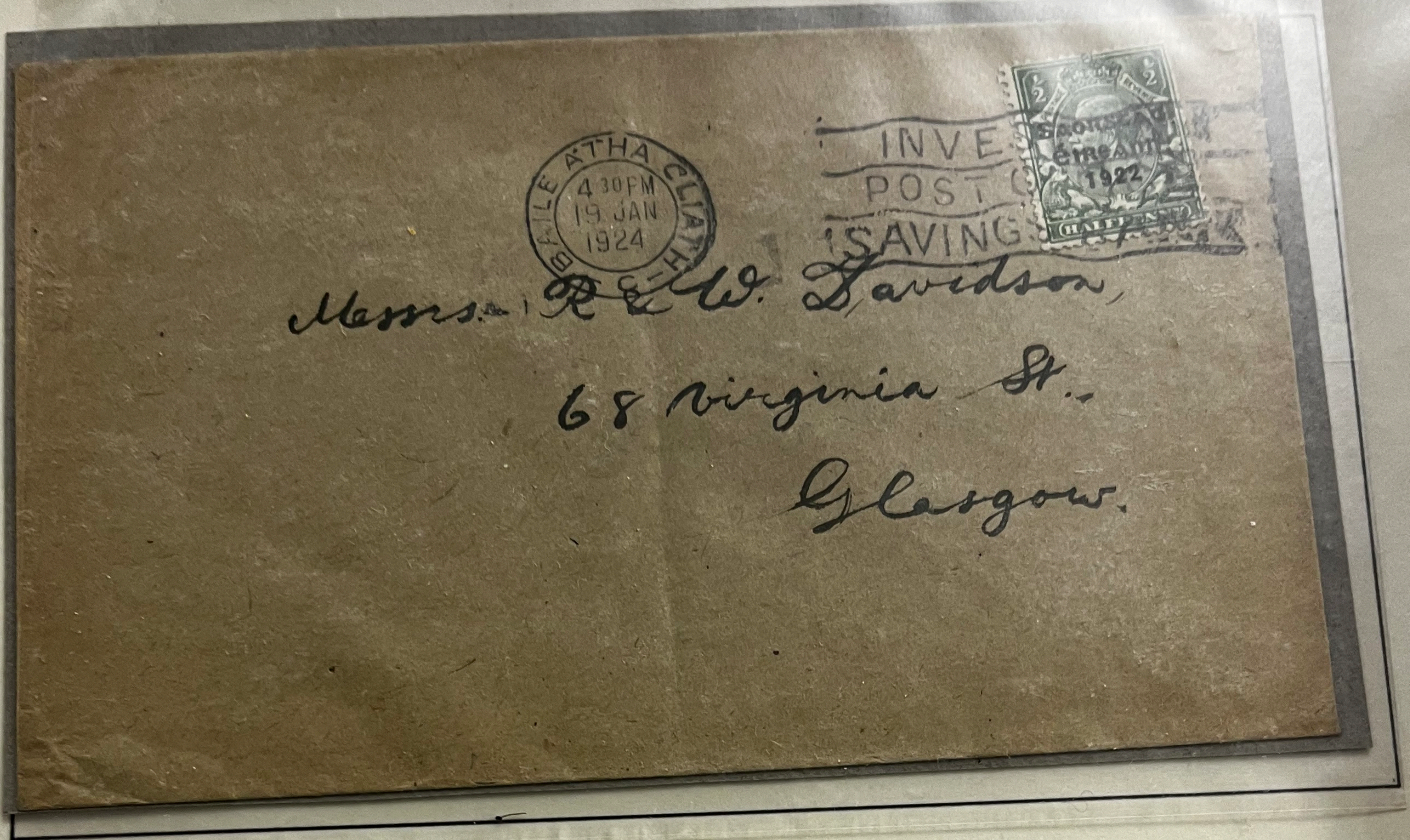


1923 Registered Dublin local usage, Overpaid 1/2 pence.
