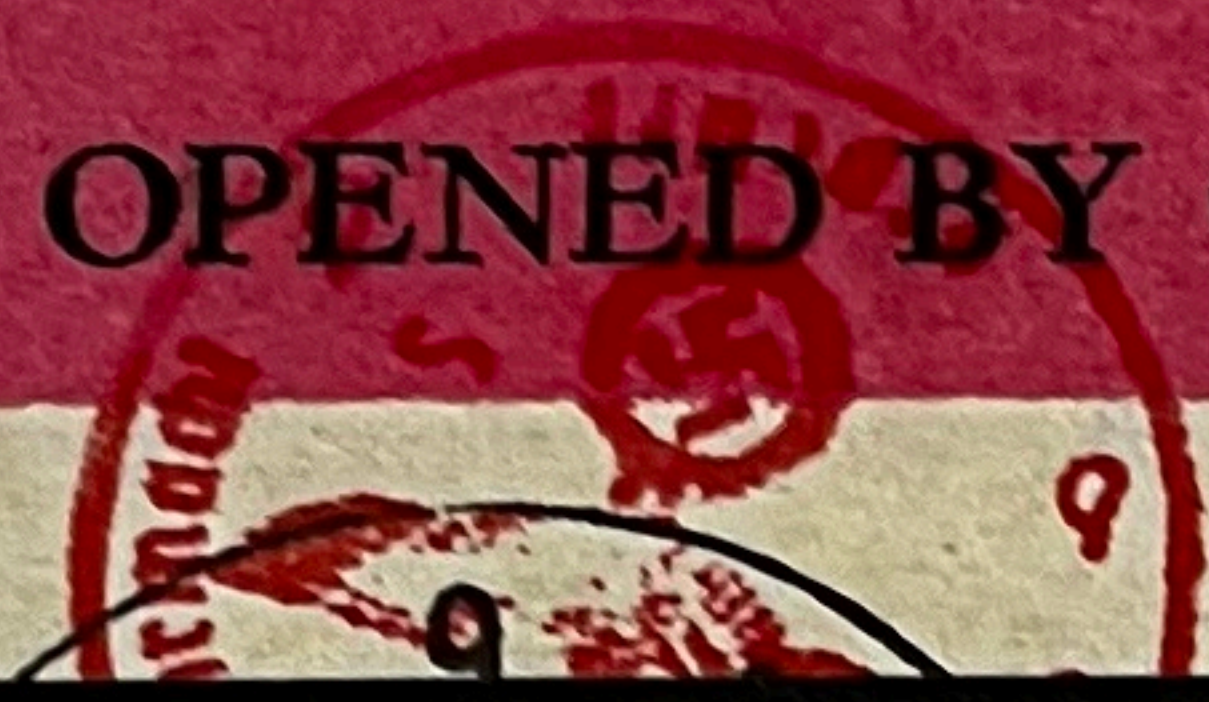

"Eingegangen am 31. 1. 42" - "Received on January 31, 1942"
Hollborn, with a crew of 4, crashed off the Irish coast near Blackwater, Co. Wexford,
in a Heinkel 111, but only he and Unteroffizier J. Emmerich survived the accident.

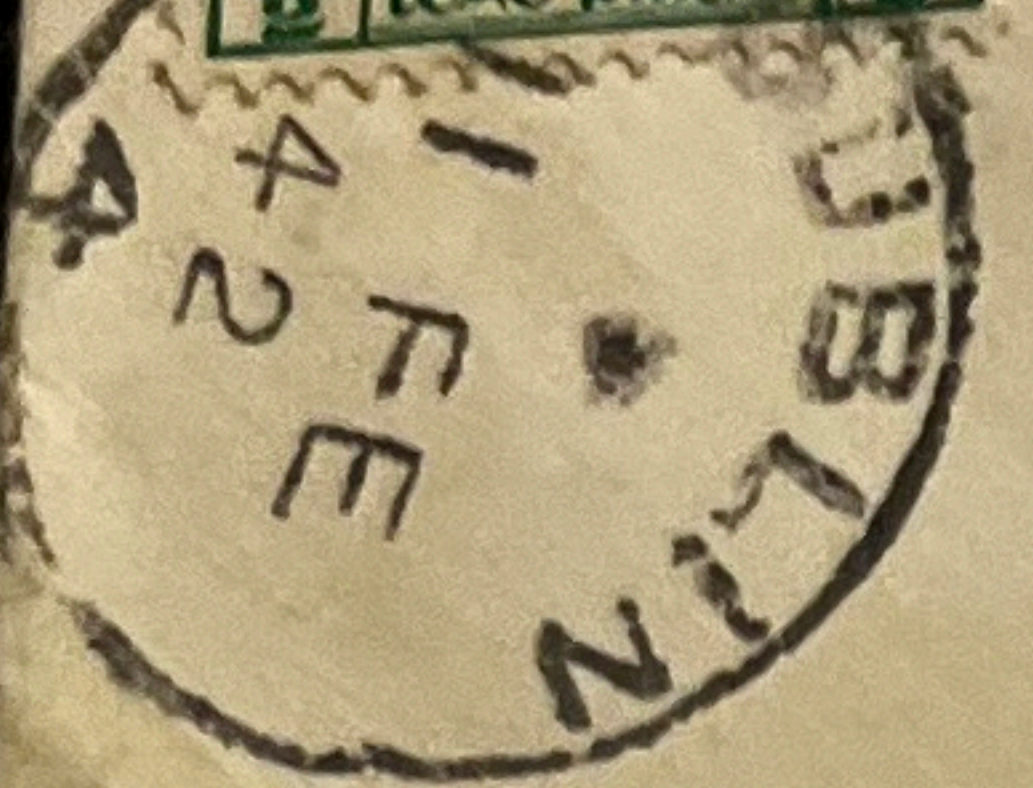
Mail from Flying Officer Denys Welphy, British Internee at the Curragh Internment Camp, to Dublin. Free postage for surface mail. Posted in Curragh on June 4, 1942. Welphy crashed in a Lockheed Hudson N7297 near Kildare while on patrol from Leuchars on January 11, 1941. Its crew, John Shaw, Denys Welphy, Roderick Cowper and Norman Todd, were interned at Curragh Camp on January 24, 1941.



Mail from Sergeant Leslie Diaper, British Internee at the Curragh Internment Camp, to Stoke-on-Trent. Free postage for surface mail. Posted in Curragh probably early 1943. Diaper crashed in a Vickers Wellington, lost and running low on fuel, on October 25, 1941, near Clonwhite, Co. Wick. Its crew, Ralph Defer, Jack Calder, Rex Virtue, Maurice Towne, Leslie Diaper and Albert Dalton, were interned at Curragh Camp at the end of October 1941.
