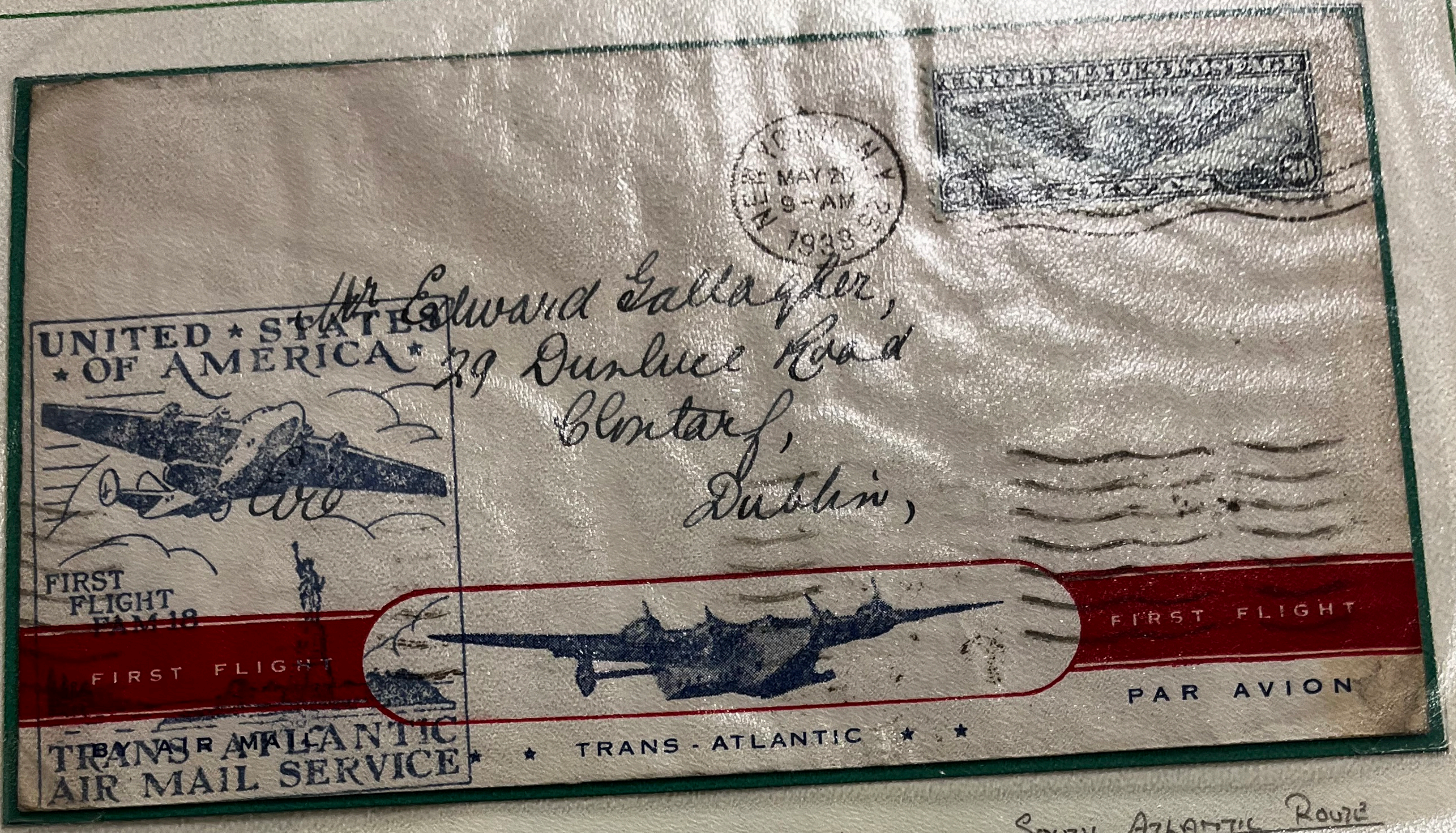

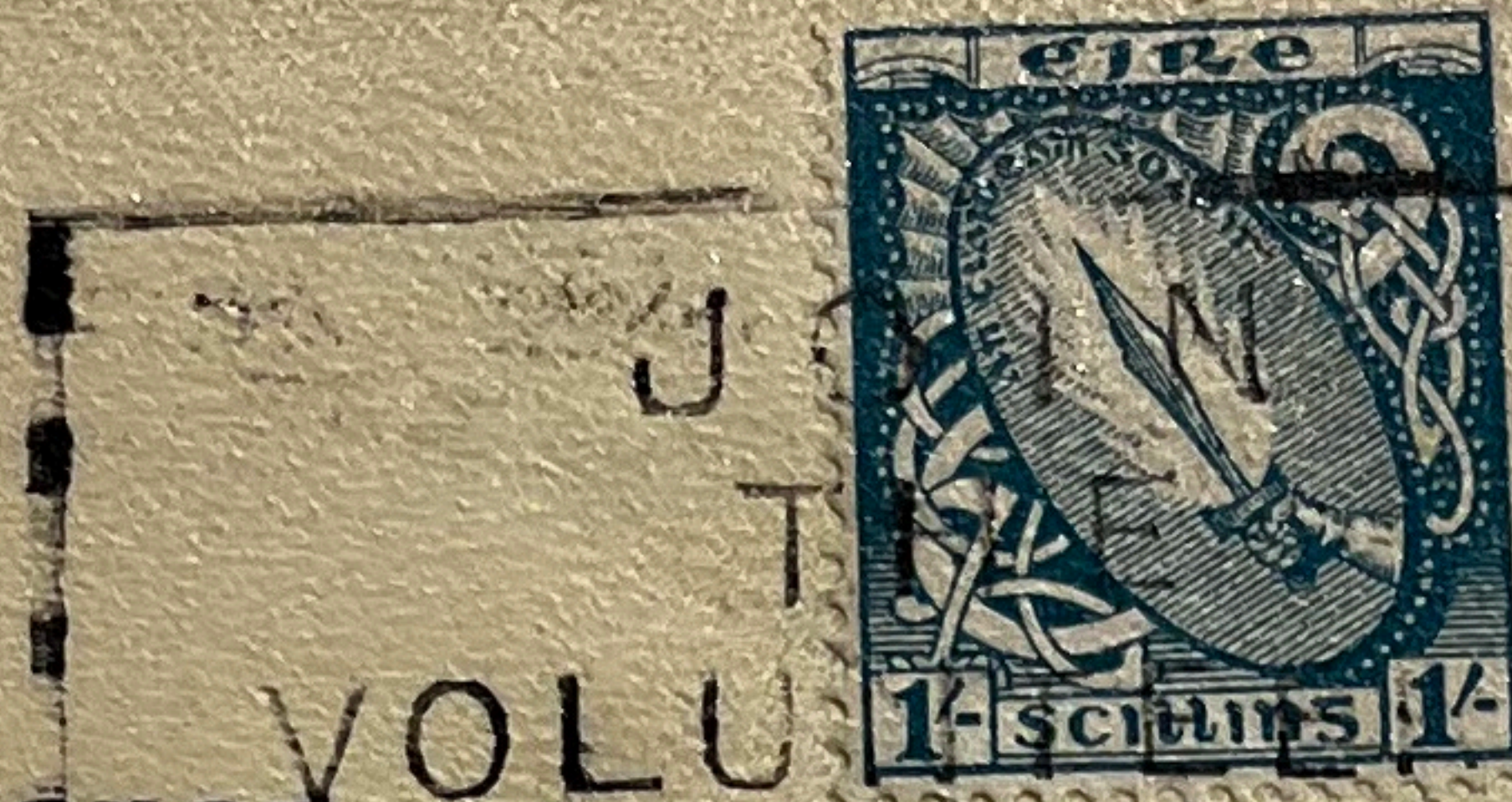
Trans-Atlantic Despatch Point: - Marseilles

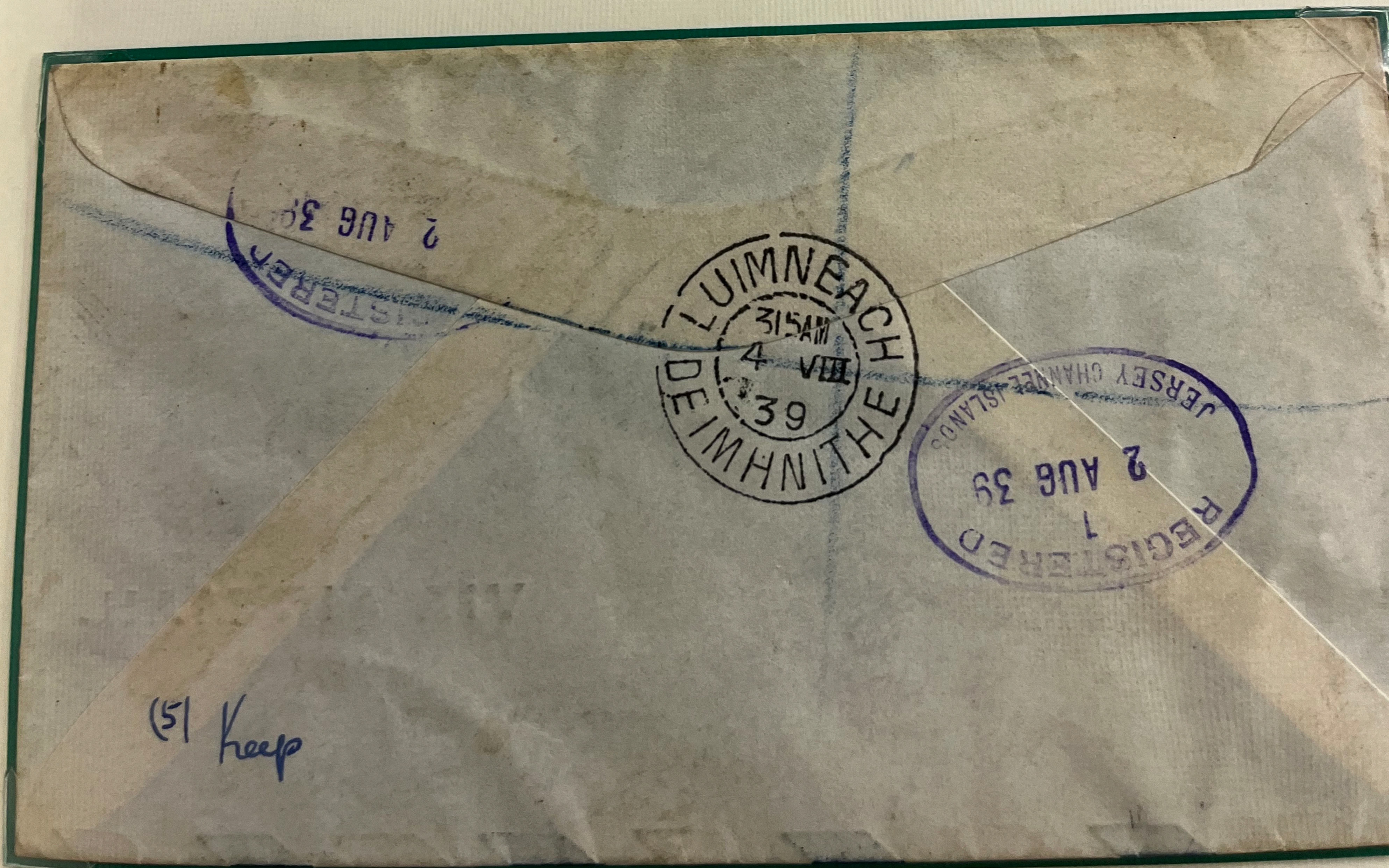
