

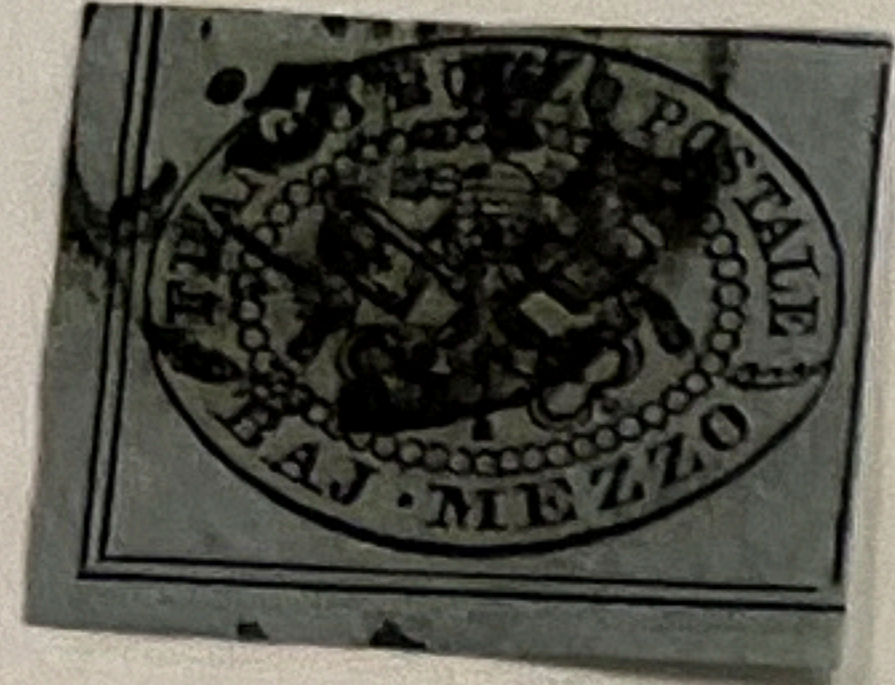
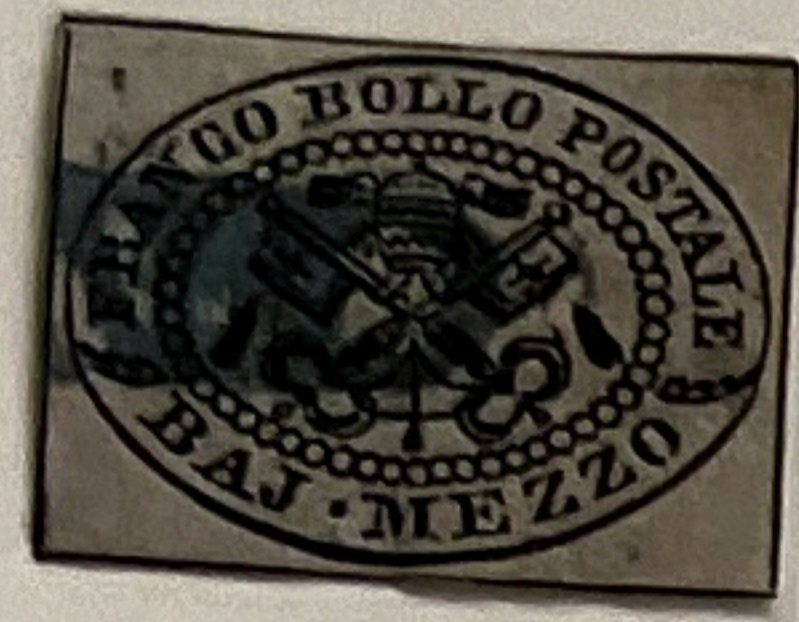

An outer letter sheet sent from Bagnacavallo to Faenza in January 1855, franked with a vertical pair of greenish grey half Bajocchi stamps which were cancelled with a lozenge grill postmark. There is a double circle arrival postmark on the reverse.



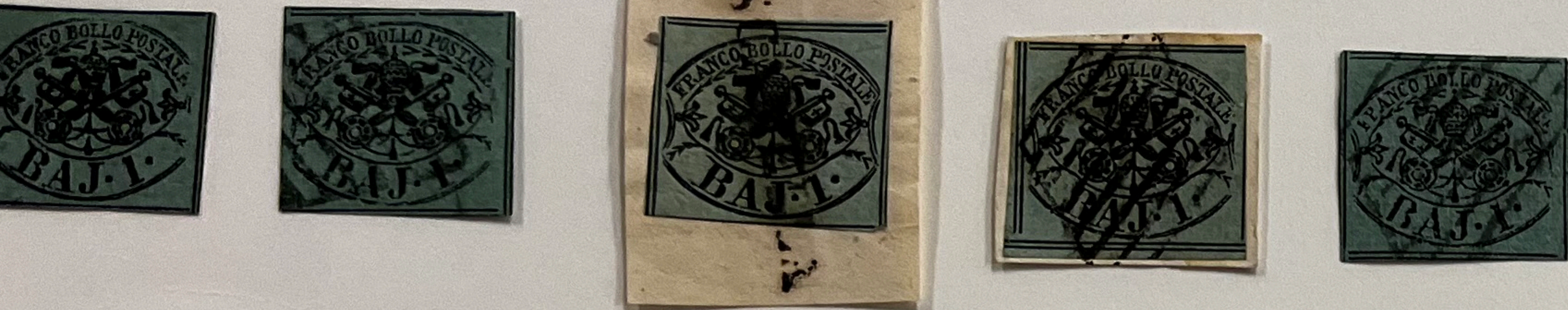
1 Bajocchi was the rate for a single weight (up to 7.5g) with the same postal district. In this case 26km between Bagnacavallo and Faenza within the Ravenna province

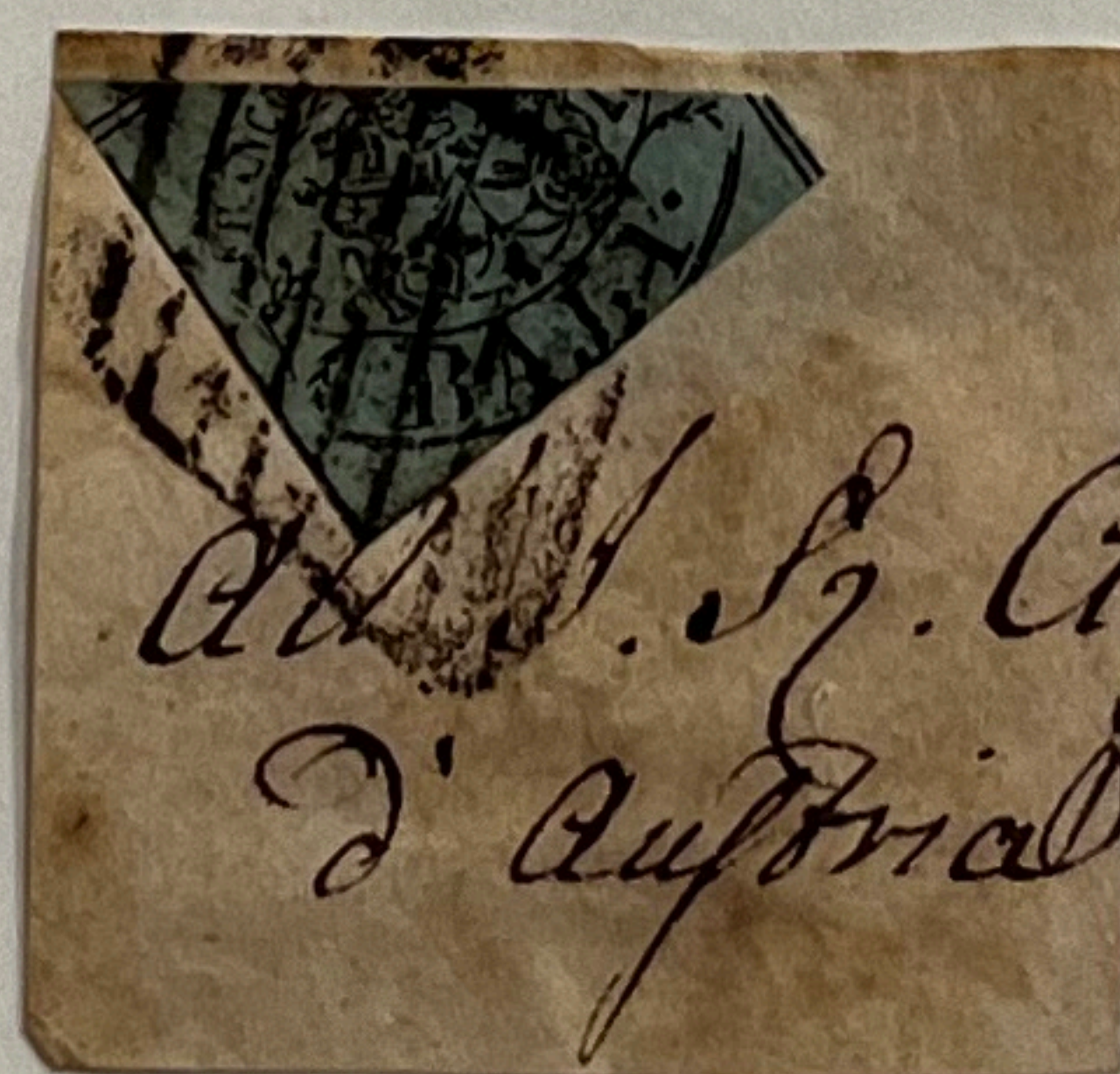
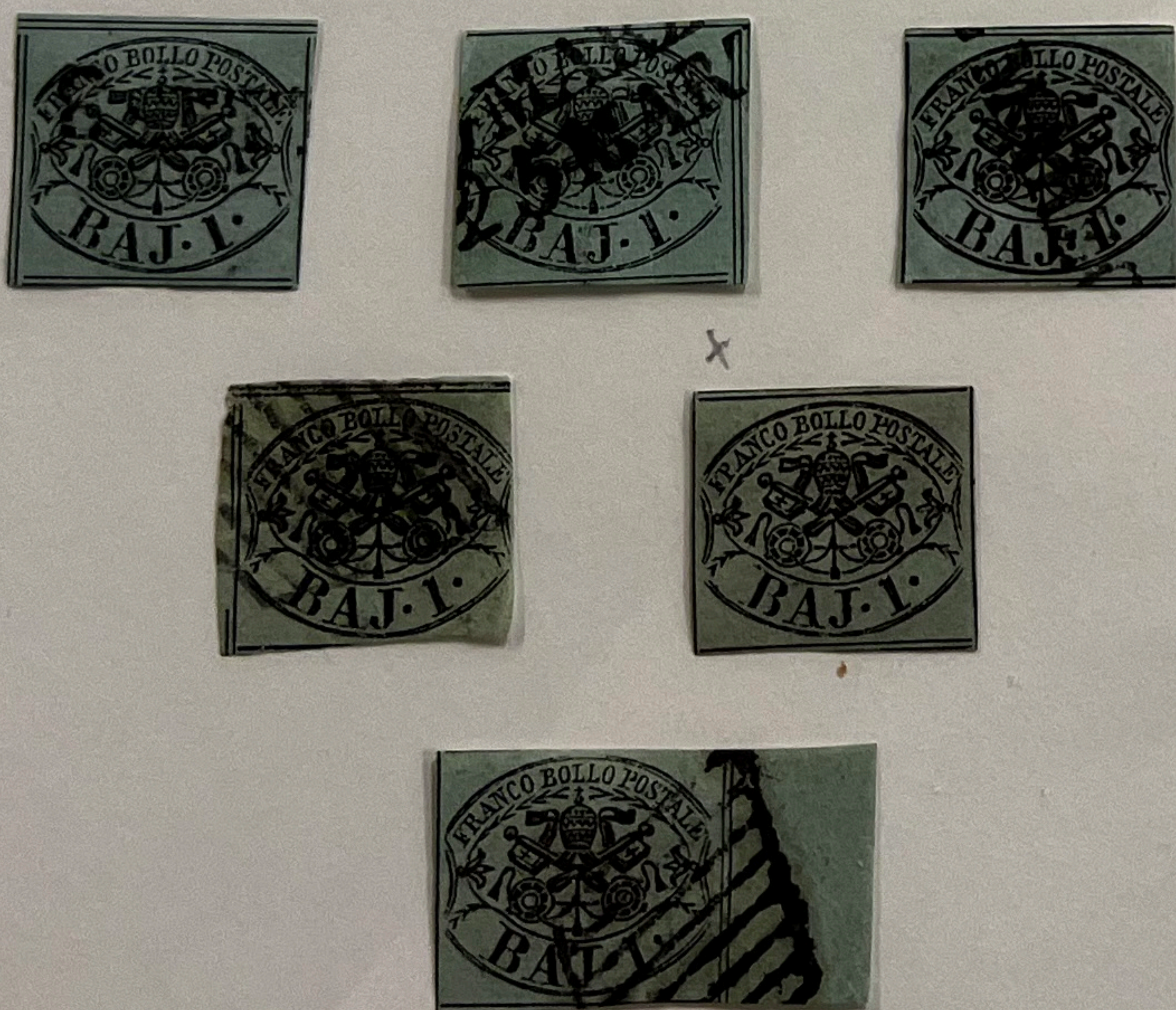

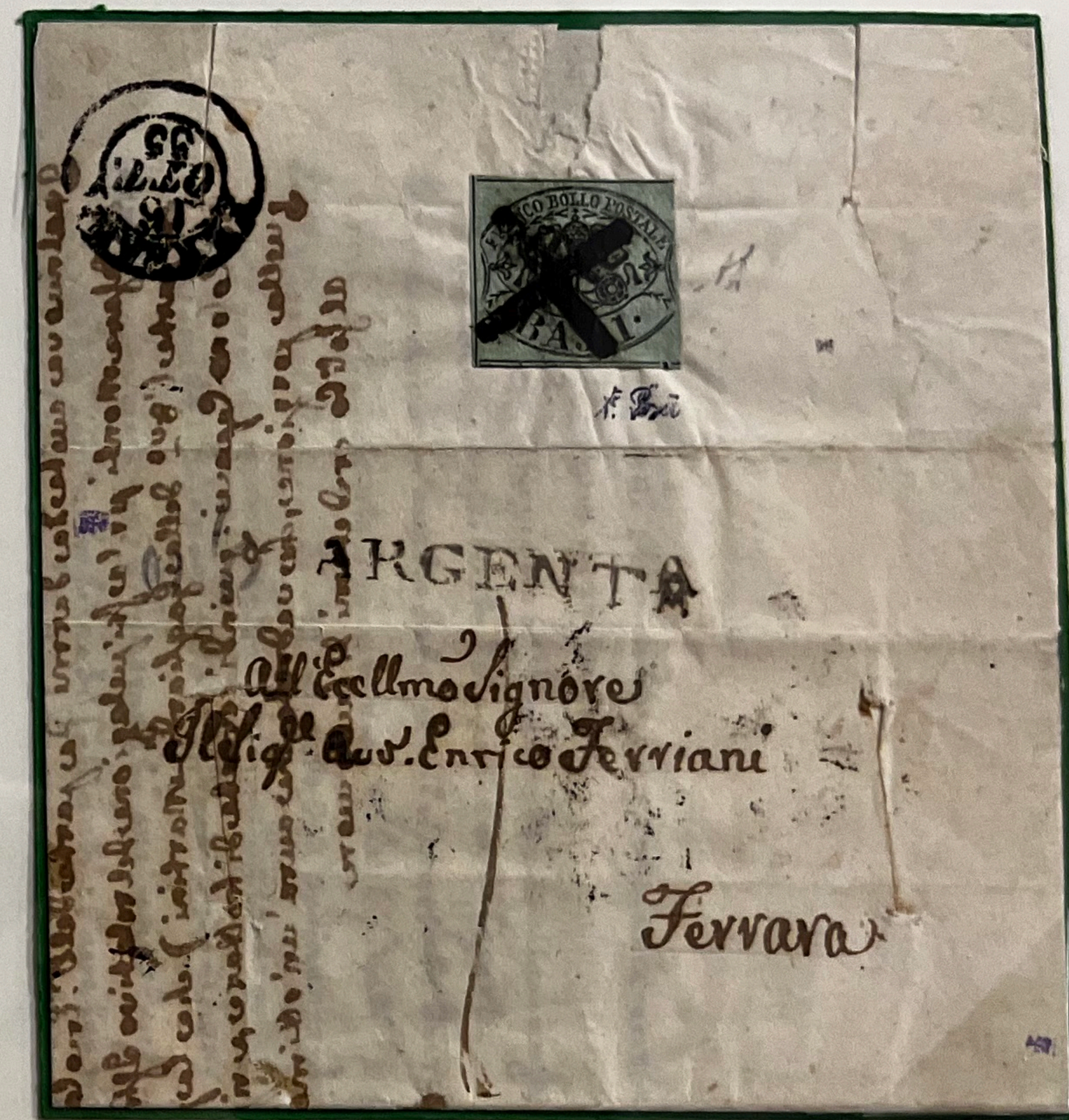

1 Baj pale green stamp bisected for use as a half Baj stamp

An entire sent from Argenta to Ferrara in October 1855. It has been sent unpaid as indicated by the manuscript "1" on the front. A 1 Baj pale green stamp has been applied on the reverse to pay the postage due: the convention at this time. The stamp was canceled by the St Andrew's cross postmark of Ferrara. 1 Bajocchi was the rate for a single weight (up to 7.5g) with the same postal district.



There are two vertical slits on the entire which would have been done at Ferrara which had a disinfection station at this time.

An outer letter sheet sent from Porto San Giorgio Grottammare in October 1859 franked with **two bisect** **2 Baj pale green stamps** on the reverse cancelled with lozenge grill postmark. Two Baj was the rate for six letter between bordering Offices of Direction, 13 miles in this case.



An entire sent from Tolentino to Macerata in November 1859 franked with 2 Baj olive green stamp cancelled with **lozenge grill** postmark.

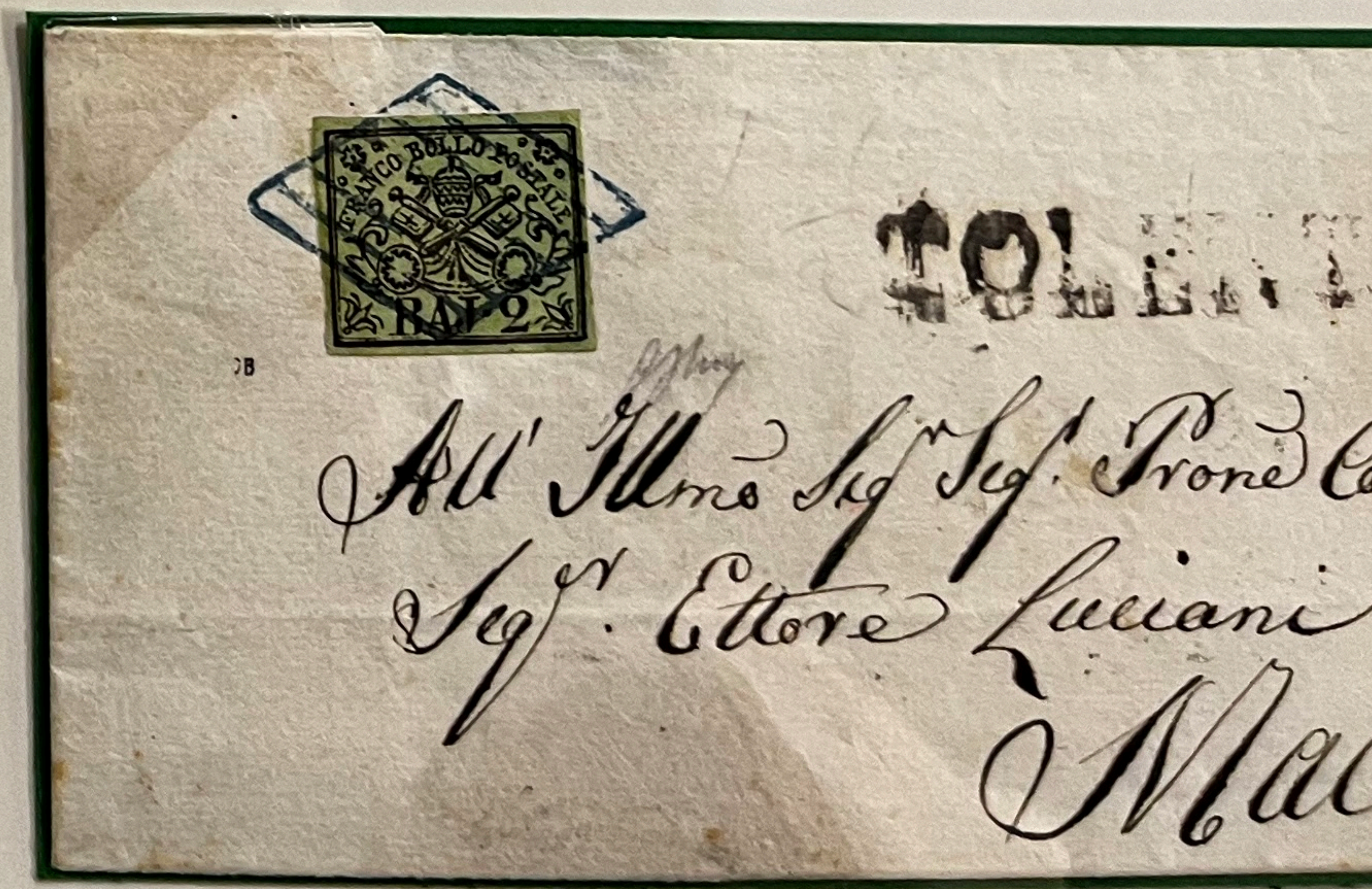

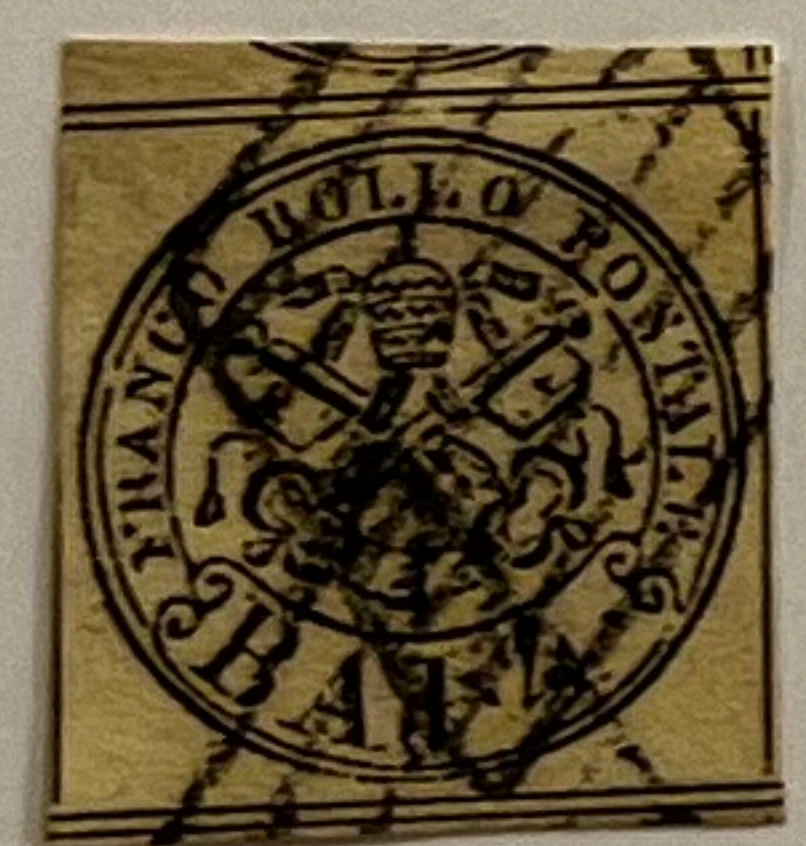

An entire sent from Rome to Malta in January 1861. It is franked with a 3 Baj pale brown and a pair of 7 Baj stamp all cancelled with the double circle Rome postmark.



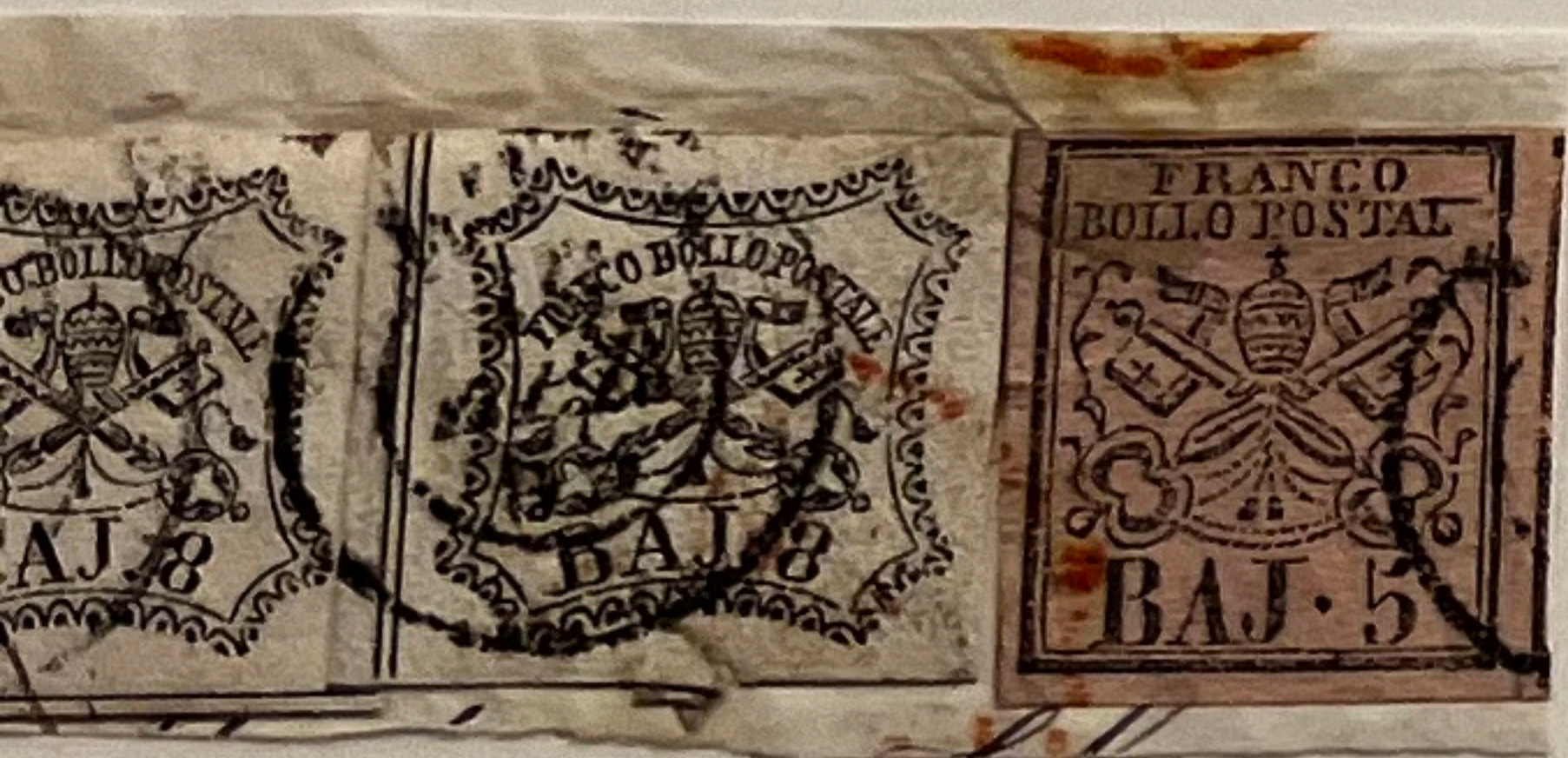
The letter is from Theresa Longworth to Captain William Yelverton, viscount Avonmore. They married in 1857 but their marriage became the subject of a notable Irish Law court case on mixed religion marriages in Ireland

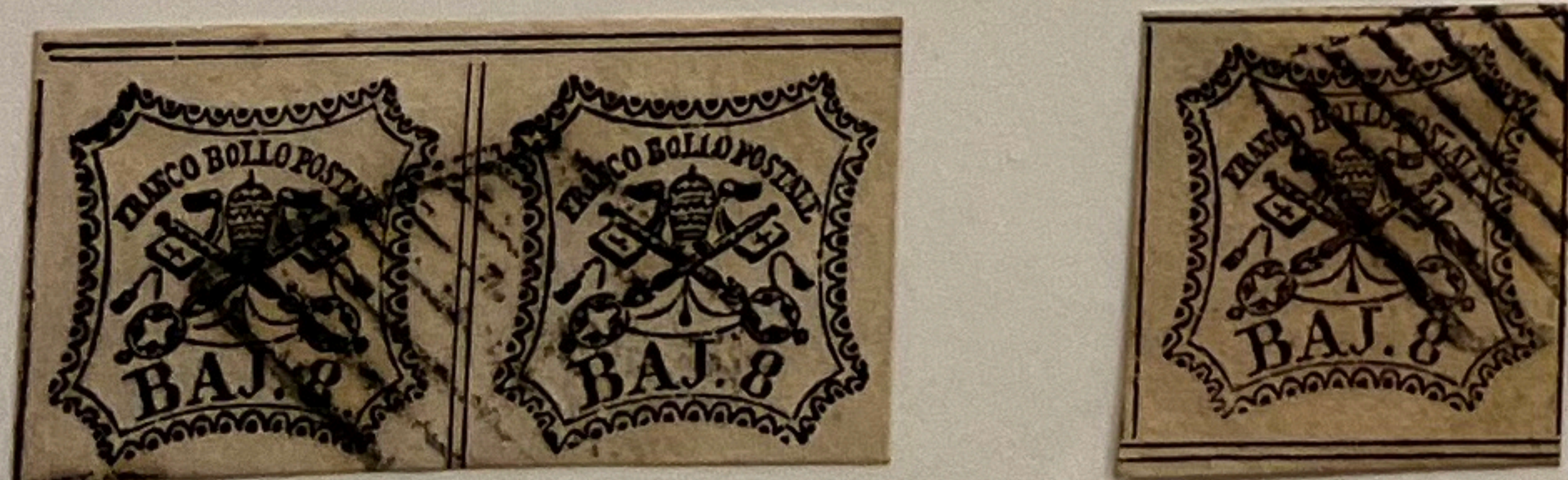

An envelope sent from Romae to Beauly in Scotland in December 1863. It is franked with a pair of 8 Baj white and a 6 Baj greenish grey stamps cancelled with the lozenge grill postmark. There is a single ring (CR/F) postmark of the Caledonian Railway at bottom left

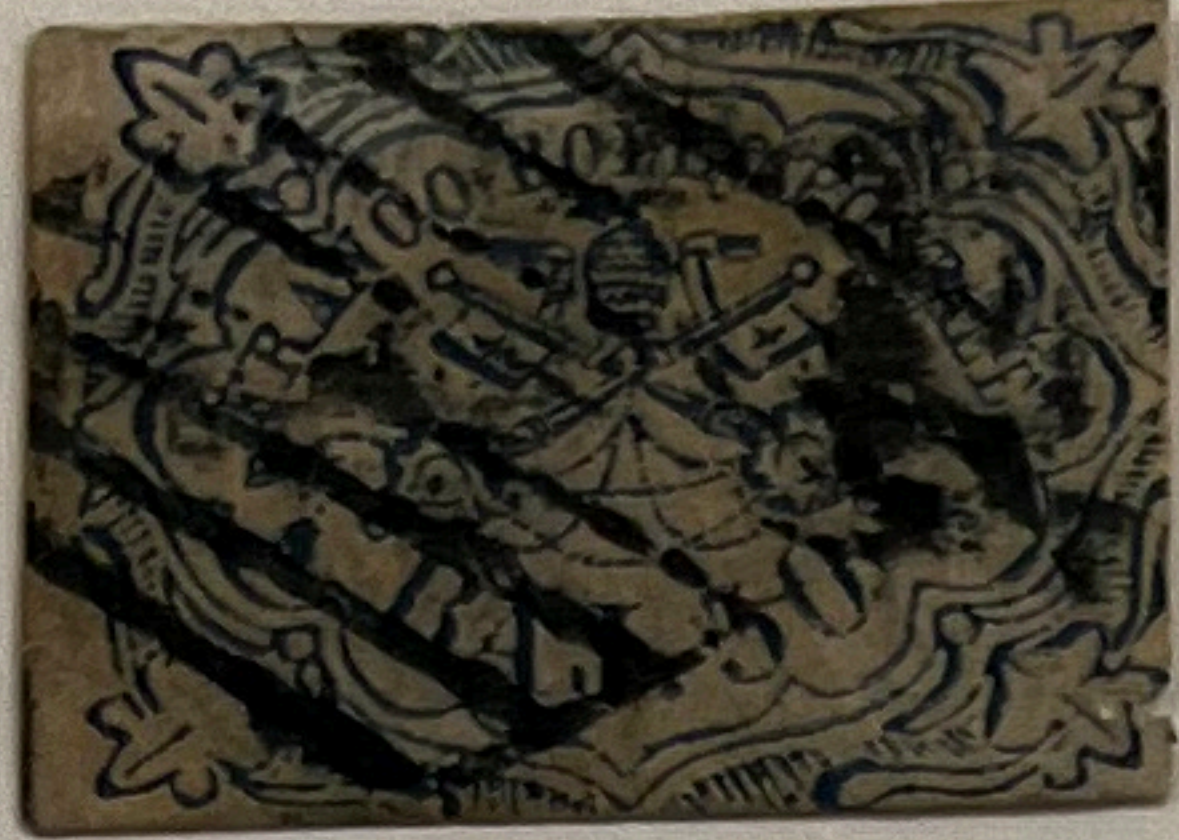

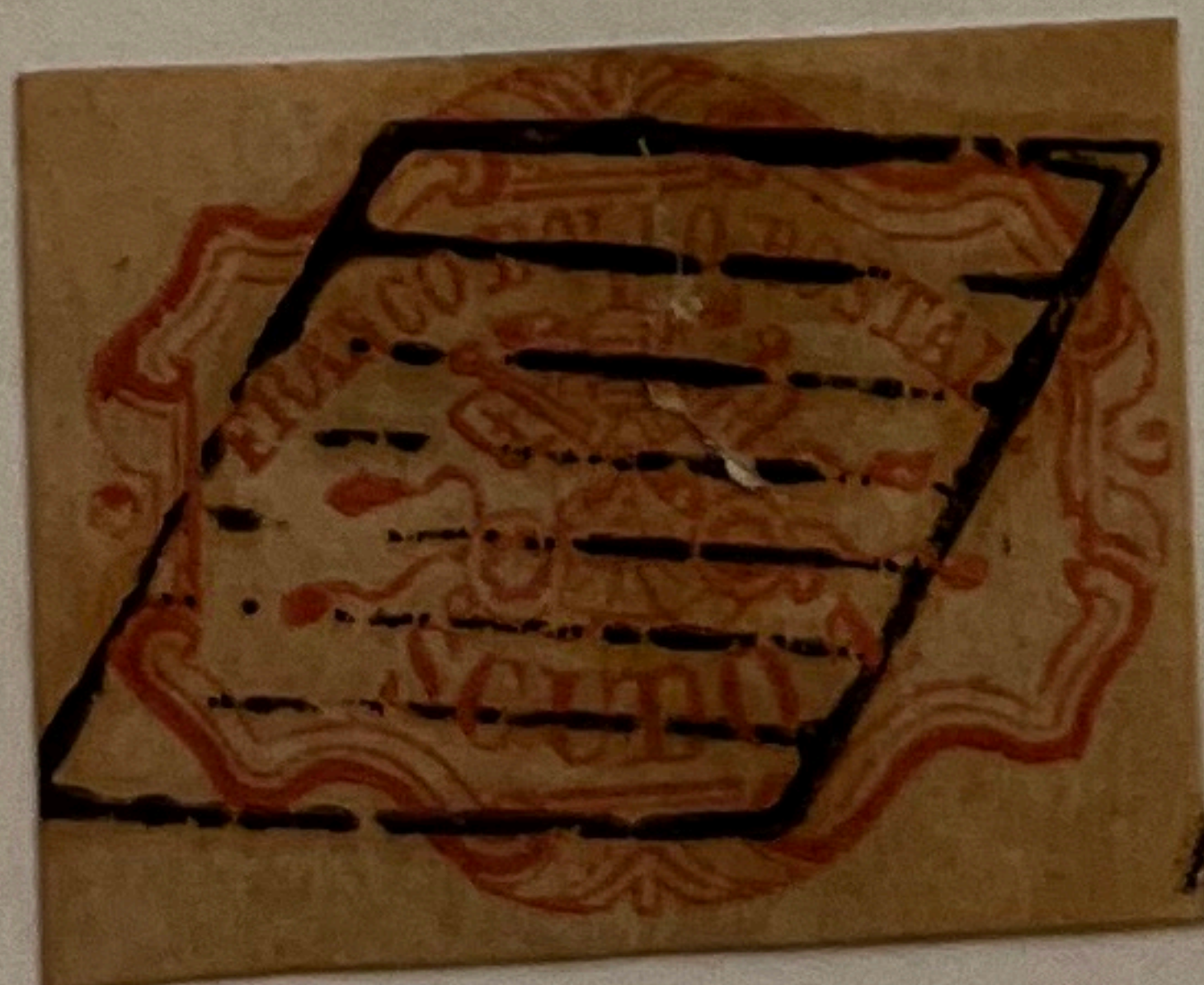
